## POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

POOL HOURS: Sunday – Thursday 9:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Friday & Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

POOL GUESTS: Any member bringing a non-member guest into the pool must pay a guest fee of \$4.00 each day and enclose the payment along with the member name and guest names in the envelopes provided on the office door. Payment MUST be made prior to the guest/guests entering the pool. There is a limit of (4) guests per day, per MEMBERSHIP HOUSEHOLD. Guests must be accompanied by the Member who brought them at all times while in the pool area. Members are liable for damages by tenants, family members or their guests, to any of the facilities at full replacement cost.

**Grandchildren:** Registered grandchildren of the Heritage Farm POA Property Owner do **NOT** need to pay a guest fee to use the pool when accompanied by the POA Property Owner that is paid up and in good standing with the HFPOA.

**NOT** bring additional guests with them. There is no additional fee for the Member's babysitter and they do not need the POA member to accompany them to the pool. However, babysitters may not use the pool when they are not babysitting for a Member's child.

Children 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult member (or babysitter) who is at least 15 years old!

ANYONE climbing or placing a child over the fence/gate or by other means to gain access to the pool area will be considered a trespasser and Benton Police will be called!

Members in violation of loaning their key to non-residents or residents with keys shut off by the POA for violations or delinquent accounts, will have their key deactivated and will NOT be allowed to use the pool or pavilion for the remainder of the year. Likewise members with keys shut off by the POA for violations or delinquent accounts who gain unauthorized access to the pool will NOT be allowed to use the pool or pavilion for the remainder of the year.

Babysitters are allowed to use the Member's key only when accompanied by the Member's child 14 and under.

All members and guests must be prepared to give identification and sign in when staff or POA board members request. Any resistance to comply or negative confrontation with staff or POA board members will result in immediate removal of all involved and barred from the pool/pavilion/playground for the remainder of the year!

No one is allowed to open the gate for others with or without a key unless they are registered members of that person's specific household or their paid guest! You MUST have your key with you when entering the pool gate!

The Health Department requires the entry gate to be closed at all times!

When the pool is **CLOSED**, if you enter, it will be considered **trespassing**.

## Usage rules and regulations:

Warning: "No" Lifeguard on duty!

Absolutely "No" Suntan Oil – Suntan Lotion is fine.

Absolutely "No" Smoking in and around the pool/pavilion including the parking area and surrounding area.

No animals in pool or in the pool fenced in area at any time.

Shower before entering pool.

Street clothes and shoes are not allowed in the water.

Infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers (accidents close the pool).

Absolutely "No" glass containers, sharp objects or any hazardous objects!

The adjacent umbrella tables are specified as a designated area for food. Be sure to place all your trash in the trash cans. All food must be kept (5) feet from the edge of the pool at all times. No food should ever be left on the ground. It must be picked up and cleaned up immediately!

Drinks may be present or consumed on the pool deck, but must be kept (5) feet from the edge of the pool.

"No" alcoholic beverages at the pool/pavilion.

"No" diving, running or offensive/foul language.

Large floats are NOT allowed during high volume usage of the pool!

All walkways around the perimeter of the pool must be clear at all times.

EVERYONE <u>must</u> clean up after their self, family and guests! Failure to do so will result in the revocation of pool and pavilion usage!
